Our traffic management employees are certified in Northern Territory Workzone Traffic Management 1,2,3. All signs and equipment are to standard AS1742.3-2009 (Uniform Traffic Control Devices Traffic Control for Work on Roads).

We service a large area of Northern Territory Government roads, from the South Australian border to Elliot, Northern Territory and to Western Australia and Queensland borders.

Peter Gurrie manages our traffic department, he is certified in NT WZTM 1,2,3 and prepares all Traffic Management Plans for our works. He has built solid long-term relationships with Northern Territory Government Departments, local contractors and the Northern Territory Police. Diggamen is the first point of call when it comes to attending call outs to traffic emergencies either operated by Police, Northern Territory Government, or Power and Water Corporation.

HYDRAULIC INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES TO HIDDEN VALLEY MOTORSPORTS COMPLEX

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

We were successful in tendering for three packages associated with the upgrades to the hydraulic infrastructure for HVMSC;

Package 3 - Upgrade works to Go-Kart Track

Works consisted of supply and installation of new 250 diameter HDPE pipework and associated works. Approx. length of 996lm.

Contract Value: \$545,300.00

Package 6 - Upgrade works around HVMSC Perimeter

Works consisted of supply & installation of new 250 diameter HDPE pipework & associated works. Approx. length of 2467lm. Construction of new water fill station & concrete access road. Variation to construct new re-fuelling bund & compound. Various variations ongoing.

Contract Value: \$1,653,300.00

Package 7 - Upgrade works to the centre of track

Works consisted of supply and installation of new 250 diameter HDPE pipework & associated works. Approx. length of 1682lm. Variation to upgrade stormwater drainage at venue entrance. Various variations ongoing.

Contract Value: \$877,400.00



DARWIN REGION - LUDMILLA CREEK CATCHMENT - FLOOD MITIGATION WORKS - CONSTRUCTION

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Works comprised of flood mitigation drainage upgrades in the areas of Dwyer Park, Reichardt Road, and Bishop Street.

A berm was constructed around the west, north & eastern sides of Dwyer Park. A shallow swale was constructed for water to drain from the park into the existing inlet structure. The existing inlet structure was upgraded with new concrete invert & steel grate for safety. Three raised pads were provided for future playground upgrades. Upgrades to the Reichardt Road inlet structure consisting of raising concrete wall, installing a concrete wall 'weir' within the structure, and cutting a new weir in the existing concrete wall on the west side were carried out. From the Reichardt Road inlet structure a new concrete trapezoidal drain was constructed in the road verge west of Reichardt Road. Three 900 x 900 RCBC culverts were installed beneath Reichardt Road & Bishop Street, including new headwalls, & removal/plugging of existing stormwater infrastructure.

Contract Value: \$1,360,200.00



PAST PERFORMANCE

DARWIN REGION – HIDDEN VALLEY MOTORSPORTS COMPLEX CIVIL & EROSION CONTROL UPGRADES

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Works were aimed at remediating existing flood damage & minimise future damage. These works were broken down into several separate works;

1. Improvement 1: Retention basins in northern carpark; provide 8 hour retention dams for a Q100 storm event across the three watercourses to increase capacity & performance of existing drainage infrastructure by approx. 50%
2. Improvement 2: Turn 1 erosion control – erosion control measures between turn 1 & 2. The current drain needs to be cleaned often and is not working properly. Earth mound level bank is proposed, which will improve drainage in the area.
3. Improvement 3: Turn 1 surface runoff – earthworks re-contour & provide levee banks to redirect stormwater runoff away from the track at turn 1.
4. Improvement 4: Turn 2 to 4 embankment – a proposed 600mm high rock barrier & reworked drain behind 1 line of protection. Currently the stormwater runoff overflows at the existing kerb along the speedway pit area on to the racetrack below.

Variation was included to construct a viewing mound at turn 10. Works included concrete footings, block work retainer walls, subsoil drainage, bulk filling, hand rail/ balustrades, concrete slabs & associated works

Contract Value: \$2,110,000.00



ALICE SPRINGS REGION – REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE OF MINOR CONCRETE STRUCTURES, DRAINAGE, PAVEMENT, ROADSIDE FURNITURE, SUPPLY AIRFIELD FURNITURE FOR A PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Re-awarded multiple times, Diggamen have been undertaking this contract since 2009, now continuing through to 2021, works comprising of;

Supply of manufactured road signs, brackets & all affiliated fixtures. Supply of road signs posts, guide posts, aerodrome furniture, work zone products & accessories. Storage & ongoing stock control of signs and fittings.

Installation of road signs, sign post anchors, posts, & all affiliated fixtures. Removal, repair, treatment of vandalised signs, & reinstallation of road signs, posts, anchors & all affiliated fixtures. Dismantling of existing posts & signs, & storage in a manner to prevent damage.

Removal of anchor/footings backfilling of post holes to same density as surrounding area. Replacing & realigning damaged signs, bolts, brackets & posts as required. Removal of all debris & excess materials from work areas.

Return of all dismantled road furniture to the contractor's depot unless specified otherwise by the Superintendent, compliance & surveillance reporting.
